We act for boards, fund managers, investors and owner-managed businesses. The work covers fund establishment and CMA licensing, mergers and acquisitions, corporate structuring and foreign investment, governance, regulatory approvals, zakat and tax, and disputes. Our practice is built around regulated industries, where a legal position has to satisfy a regulator as well as a board.

A partner leads every engagement, working with the specialists the matter calls for. We keep the team small and senior, and take a limited number of matters at a time. Our advice gives you a position you can act on, what it means for the business, and what needs to be decided. Where the law is unsettled, we say so. We work in Arabic and English, and deal with regulators directly.
